 - 5/6 Puyallup debrief

 - Puyallup President responded with an email with internal measures that will be taken within their club

 - Board member commitments & recruitment
 - May need to stagger terms in the bylaws – currently all seats are up for election – may need to make some of the terms for this fall’s election for 1 year, which then change to 2 years after
