



# **NORTH SPRINGS LITTLE LEAGUE**

## **GENERAL POLICIES – PANDEMIC MODIFICATIONS**

**North Springs Little League has developed a series of guidelines and protocols designed to safely get our kids back on the field while adhering to the latest recommendations from Little League International and local county/city officials. These policies go into effect immediately and will remain in place until further notice.**

- **All coaches, or any other approved adult, in the dugout will be required to wear a mask/face covering.**
- **Players are not required to wear masks/face coverings during play or in the dugout. However, it is certainly acceptable should the player or guardian request.**
- **Spectators are recommended to wear masks/face coverings OR maintain 6 feet social distancing.**
- **Unapproved parents are not permitted in the dugout or on the field at any time.**
- **Anyone showing any signs of sickness (a snuffle, cough, slight fever, etc.) should stay home under all circumstances.**
- **Any league official or team coach that suspects an illness with one of the players must immediately pause play or practice, identify the child's guardian and **POSITIVELY** address the situation and excuse the child from play.**
- **Safe distancing of players will be observed in the dugout while players are seated.**
- **Additional guidelines may be posted during our season by city/county officials and will take precedent.**

As a program run entirely by Volunteers, we need your help in being considerate of others by following all of these guidelines, all of the time. Yes, it is different from the norm but certainly far better than the alternative of cancelling the season entirely.

Some of our regular house-rules will be relaxed, specifically in the number of players required to play a game. We realize that more than normal absences will occur. The ultimate goal is to get as many kids playing our great game as often as possible.
