

# Arizona Cactus Cup International Hockey Tournament - Respect for Tournament Staff – Communication Policy

## Respecting Tournament Staff

Throughout the tournament:

- Staff members are performing assigned duties and supporting game operations
- Staff must be able to work without interference, confrontation, or disrespect
- All communication with staff must remain calm, professional, and courteous
- Any form of aggressive behavior, arguing, or disrespect toward tournament staff is not permitted and may result in removal from the facility or additional disciplinary action.

## Who May Approach Tournament Staff

To maintain order and ensure accurate communication:

Only the following individuals may approach tournament staff:

- Head Coaches
- Assistant Coaches
- Official Team Managers

Parents, spectators, and players **shall** not approach tournament staff regarding scheduling, game rulings, scorekeeping, officiating, or administrative matters.

If a concern arises, it must be communicated through the team's coach or manager, who will then speak with staff as needed.
